- Negotiate with carriers for specific named accounts
- Understand country's needs and negotiate specific requirements with target carriers, e.g. space protection/allocation, free time on demurrage and detention etc.
- Obtain and maintain port to port Sea Logistics rates with carriers based on market analysis and knowledge and also uploading related contracts into sea rates
- Ensure efficient flow of information concerning carriers and market development to all involved stake holders
- Identify opportunities to increase the profitability by targeting new customers and/or increasing business with existing customers
- Escalate and Assist in Resolving Operational Issues
